## 9th York & Lancaster Regt.

2nd Lieut. AGUSTUS ANDREW DENYER.

Near YPRES on 9th April 1917. This officer was in the front line for the first time. The enemy bombarded our trenches continuously for twelve hours with shells of heavy calibre, and then raided that part of the front line held by 'D' Coy, to which 2nd Lieut. DENYER belongs. The enemy obtained a footing in the trenches and was successfully driven out by a bombing party led by this officer. They left four killed and two prisoners in our hands.

The courage and determination of this young officer was a very fine example to the men.
